## Alan Kline rides wave at Fasig-Tipton Midlantic sale

**M**aryland breeder Alan Kline scored a major coup at this year's Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Preferred Two-Year-Olds in Training sale, selling a filly by Street Cry (Ire) for \$200,000.

The most expensive Maryland-bred in the auction held May 21 and 22 at Timonium, Kline's filly, sold by Randy Miles as agent, represented superb timing on the part of Kline, who bred her in a foal-sharing arrangement with Darley (Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum's Kentucky establishment that is home to her sire).

Street Cry's first crop of 2-year-olds—led by Breeders' Cup Juvenile-G1 winner and Eclipse Award champion Street Sense—had yet to make an impact when the breeders consigned his daughter out of Kline's mare Peace Tech (by Peace for Peace) to last year's Keeneland September Yearling sale.

When the filly spurred almost no interest among buyers—and Darley was ready to let her go at any price—Kline bought her on his own account for \$17,000.

"There was a lot of luck involved," admits Kline. "But I really liked the filly. I was ready to keep her anyway—and would have raced her,

if she hadn't sold well at the Maryland sale."

Lawley-Wakelin Bloodstock bought Kline's filly.

Proprietor of 120-acre Honey Acres Farm in Boyds, Md., Kline—a semi-retired accountant—has operated a successful commercial breeding operation for many years, and currently maintains 13 broodmares.

His latest sales star comes from one of Kline's foundation families. Kline bought the filly's granddam, \*Yanina II, for \$21,000 at the 1978 Keeneland November sale. A multiple stakes winner in Argentina, \*Yanina II was in foal to Stop

the Music when Kline brought her back to his Maryland farm. Her colt born the following year, and two of her next three foals, were only modest winners, but Kline enjoyed superb racing success with \*Yanina II's 1985 daughter, Ice Tech (by Icecapade), who won or placed in seven stakes, including a victory in the Grade 3 Honey Bee Handicap, with D. Wayne Lukas as her trainer.

Peace Tech, the sales filly's dam, was the final foal produced by \*Yanina II. She was sired by Kline's home stallion Peace for Peace, a son of Hold Your Peace whom Kline bought as a yearling and cam-

paigned to win multiple stakes before retiring him to stand at Honey Acres. Peace for Peace died of a heart attack after making just one cover in his fifth season at stud, in 1989.

Kline was deeply saddened by the loss of Peace for Peace, and has not stood a stallion at Honey Acres since.

Peace Tech, a foal of 1987, never made it to the races, but as a broodmare she has been prolific. The dam of 14 foals, including stakes-placed Darnestown (\$94,280) and hard-hitting winners Ultra Tech (\$102,400) and Senorita Rose (\$90,398), Peace Tech has a yearling colt by Deputy Commander and an Aptitude filly at her side. She was bred this season to Not For Love.

Kline counts one other member of the family among

his broodmares—the recently retired Ultra Tech (by Maria's Mon), who is in foal for 2008 to Northern Afleet.

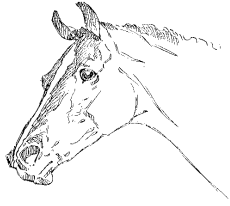

## Chesapeake Bay targeted watershed grant

The Maryland Department of Agriculture (MDA) has received a \$700,000 Chesapeake Bay targeted watershed grant to help owners and operators of small-sized equine operations in central Maryland with pasture and manure management.

The 2002 Maryland Equine Census found this region has one of the largest concentrations of horses in Maryland.

Partners in the project are the MDA, the University of Maryland Cooperative Extension and Equine Studies Program, the Horse Outreach Workgroup, Maryland Department of the Environment, soil conservation districts, the Maryland Horse Industry Board and the U.S. Department of Agriculture's Natural Resources Conservation Service.

### Katie's Love

While Maryland-bred Declan's Moon was gath-

ering press clippings competing against the elite in California—and earning the Eclipse Award as the nation's champion 2-year-old male in 2004—his close relative Katie's Love typically appeared as a footnote.

Katie's Love (by Not For Love), a half-sister to Declan's Moon's dam, had in fact outshone Declan's Moon the only time they met in competition. That was in the 2003 Maryland Horse Breeders Association Yearling Show, where each of the youngsters bred by Howard County horseman Brice Ridgely took a coveted blue ribbon from the judge,

Barclay Tagg. After pinning them first in their individual classes, Tagg passed over Declan's Moon to select Katie's Love as grand champion.

Both were sold at the 2003 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Eastern Fall Yearling sale—Declan's Moon for \$125,000 and Katie's Love for \$60,000.

Now, at age 5, Katie's Love is a stakes winner in her own right.

Carrying the colors of Lewis Family Racing Stable (Dr. Fred T. Lewis of Clarksville, Md., her purchaser at the yearling sale), she captured the Shine Again Stakes on May 26 at Pimlico in her 31st career start.

Katie's Love closed determinedly to score by three-quarters of a length over Hanaiei Bay, with Take a Check holding on for third. Completing the field were (1.1-1 favorite) Miss Lombardi, Lonaconing and Seattle's Bodgit. Final time for the mile and a sixteenth was 1:45.51.

Trained throughout her career by Nancy Alberts (the local conditioner famous as the breeder, owner and trainer of 2002 Maryland-bred Horse of the Year and Preakness runner-up Magic Weisner), Katie's Love placed in two stakes last year, finishing second in the Justakiss Stakes at Delaware Park and third in the Geisha Handicap at Laurel.

She has won or placed in 19 of her outings, earning \$217,580.

Ridgely's experiences with the family of Katie's Love are among the most remarkable in Maryland breeding history.

It all began in 1997 when Ridgely, responding to an advertisement in the *Baltimore Sun*, bought a package consisting of two broodmares and a yearling. The mares cost a total of \$3,500, and Ridgely tossed in another \$3,500 for the just-turned Norquestor yearling, whom he named Vee Vee Star.

Vee Vee Star placed in two stakes for Ridgely, including a third in the Grade 2 Black-Eyed Susan Stakes won by Silverbulletday. Then, as her second foal, she produced Declan's Moon (by former Maryland stallion Malibu Moon).

Undeclared at 2, with victories in three California graded stakes, culminating in the Grade 1 Hollywood Futurity, Declan's Moon took the Maryland-bred Horse of the Year title along with national championship honors. He campaigns for Mace and Samantha Siegel's Jay Em Ess Stable, which purchased him at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Yearling sale from the consignment of agent Bill Reightler.

An early favorite for the 2005 Kentucky Derby, Declan's Moon was sidelined by an injury in March of his 3-year-old season, and has not returned to his earlier form. He most recently finished third in a seven and a half-furlong allowance race on May 17 at Hollywood Park, boosting his earnings to \$668,900 from 12 career starts.

Vee Vee Star's dam, Fabulous Vee (a 1985 daughter of Somethingfabulous), was one of the mares in the package deal. She was barren when Ridgely brought her home to his Spring Meadow Farm in

Cooksville, where she now resides as a pensioner. Fabulous Vee produced six foals for Ridgely, with Katie's Love being by far her best to date.

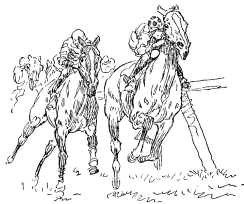
Fabulous Vee's final foal is a yearling Jump Start filly.
