## Binnie Houghton: Horse breeding is in her blood

Year after year since the 1960s, good Maryland-bred performers have hit the ground running at picturesque Buckingham Farm on the shores of the Chester River on Maryland's Eastern Shore.

And the farm's proprietor, Elizabeth (known to all as Binnie) Houghton, is not about to let that change, despite catastrophic events of the past few years.

The death of her husband, E. Edward (Eddie) Houghton, in August 2008 at the age of 67, left Binnie Houghton reeling. All but inseparable, the couple led a life filled with outdoor adventure and shared devotion to an array of animals—not just raising horses but racing and showing mules, and welcoming a succession of llamas, zebras and other unusual inhabitants to the pastures at Buckingham Farm.

Less than a year after losing Eddie, Binnie lost the main barn at Buckingham. Burned to the ground, of still unidentified causes, the building contained many cherished items, including photographs and well-worn trappings from the earliest years of their marriage, though thankfully no animals were inside at the time.

"It's enough to make you want to get out of the business," concedes Houghton, who along with her husband raised five Maryland-bred champions and winners of four Maryland Million Classics. "But the horse business has always been in my blood."

The good news is that Houghton's perseverance was rewarded in 2010.

Buckingham Farm was represented as the breeder of two stakes winners, including Fascinat' Rhythm, who

carried Houghton's colors to victory in two stakes, while pushing her earnings to \$230,823.

Roaring Lion, now the top earner for Maryland sire Lion Hearted, furthered his fortunes with a duo of stakes wins for Repole Stable at Monmouth Park. Roaring Lion won the 2006 Maryland Juvenile Championship Stakes while racing as a homebred for the Houghtons and was claimed from them in the fall of his 3-year-old cam-

paign. His earnings now total \$493,536 from 30 starts, with an additional victory in the 2009 Maryland Million Sprint.

Binnie Houghton's love for Thoroughbred racing was inherited, at least in part, from her father, Anderson Fowler, who lived in Gladstone, N.J., but raised and raced homebreds from Buckingham Farm and remained a cornerstone of Maryland's breeding industry until his death in 1997. Through her late mother, Genevieve Brady Fowler, Houghton is a niece of James Cox Brady, the famed breeder and one-time chairman of the New York Racing Association.

Her cousins James Cox Brady and Nicholas F. Brady (who was Secretary of the Treasury during the Reagan administration) remain active in the business under the name of Mill House.

Buckingham Farm is also woven through the family history of 2006 Kentucky Derby-

G1 winner Barbaro, whose eighth dam, the Man o' War daughter War Feathers, was purchased as a yearling in 1925 by Houghton's grandfather, James Cox Brady, for a then-record auction price of \$50,500.

Fascinatin' Rhythm (by More Than Ready) hails from this same family, her stakes-winning dam April Gator being a daughter of Green Alligator, the Gate Dancer colt who carried Anderson Fowler's colors to a fourth-place finish in the 1991 Kentucky Derby. Green Alligator's dam, La Reine Rouge (by King's Bishop), is the granddam of Barbaro.

Currently, Binnie Houghton's Thoroughbred stock is reduced to five broodmares (four to foal in 2011), two yearlings and two 2-year-olds. She has four horses, including Fascinatin' Rhythm, in training with Maryland-based conditioner Richard W. (Dickie) Small.

Not surprisingly, each of her broodmares has strong roots at Buckingham. They consist of:

- Palliser Bay, a 1992 daughter of Frosty the Snowman—Caro Keri, by Caro (Ire), who has produced two standouts by leading Maryland sire Not For Love: 2004 Maryland-bred champion 3-year-old filly He Loves Me, a graded winner of \$355,698, and multiple stakes winner For Kisses (\$344,056). Palliser Bay raced for the Houghtons after being purchased for \$32,000 at the 1994 Ocala Breeders' Sales Company March 2-year-olds in training sale, winning the 1997 Gallorette Handicap-G3 and two other stakes; also six times stakes-placed, she earned \$248,623. She has a 2-year-old Langfuhr filly. Barren for 2010, Palliser Bay is due to foal this season to Not For Love.

- For Kisses, a foal of 2003 (see above), owned in partnership with Susie and Wayne Chatfield-Taylor. After five seasons of racing, she was bred for the first time in 2010. In foal to Indian Charlie, she's booked to Bluegrass Cat.

- Smartly, 1992, Horatius—Carefully Taught, by Majestic Prince. From a long line of distinguished runners bred by the Bradys, Smartly produced Roaring Lion as her sixth foal, and first stakes performer. When Roaring Lion won his first stakes at 2, the Houghtons had already relegated Smartly to the "back

field," but they returned her to production. She's in foal for 2011 to Lion Hearted. Smartly raced for the Houghtons, winning or placing in 23 of 38 starts, including a victory in the Sham Say Stakes, and earning \$172,329.

- Petunia, 1996, Lil E. Tee—Here Comes Betty, by Cox's Ridge. A product of the late Allaire duPont's breeding program, Petunia was purchased by the Houghtons for \$29,000 at the 1998 Ocala Breeders' Sales Company April sale of 2-year-olds in training. A stakes winner and graded-placed earner of \$194,849, she has a Smarty Jones yearling.

- Aunt Elaine, 2003, Charismatic—Annie Cake, by Gate Dancer. A winner of \$91,190, homebred Aunt Elaine is also from the family of Barbaro. She has a yearling colt by Dance With Ravens and is in foal for 2011 to Two Punch.

Also in residence at Buckingham, overseen by longtime farm manager Mark Stallings, are five ponies, two mules, three donkeys and five llamas—along with the farm's typically generous array of Thoroughbred pensioners that includes Foolish Pole, the now 18-year-old Polish Numbers gelding who won or placed in 11 stakes and earned \$445,850 while campaigning as a homebred for Fowler.

"We take care of them so well that they tend to live forever," says Houghton. 🐾

Hillwood Stable LLC's Love's Reason lived up to her billing as the 3-2 favorite when she outstepped four rivals in the \$50,000 Maryland Juvenile Filly Championship Stakes at Laurel Park on December 11. Morning line favorite Indian Tale was scratched.

The daughter of Not For Love completed the seven and a half furlongs in 1:33.88 and carried Travis Dunkelberger to a two and a quarter-length victory. Oriental Cruise, who battled for the lead into the stretch, held off late-closing Side by Side to finish second. Completing the field were

Congaree Princess and Malibu Beach Bunny.

"She put it all together today," said Dunkelberger.

Love's Reason improved her record to two wins and four in-the-money finishes in five career starts. She was a close third (behind Doing Great and Twelve Pack Shelly) in the Maryland Million Lassie on October 2 at Laurel. Her only off-the-board finish was in her previous start at Delaware Park on October 25 when she "flipped out" in the paddock and ran next to last.

"She's got all the ability in the world," said trainer Rodney Jenkins. "I love her but she is definitely a challenge. She got a little flighty at Delaware so we had to regroup. We put blinkers on her and it really seemed to help."

Owner Ellen Charles, who campaigns under the banner of Hillwood Stable, purchased Love's Reason for \$75,000 at the 2009 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic Eastern Fall Yearling sale.

John T. Crane Jr. and Margaret M. Crane bred the filly from stakes-placed Elaines Reason (1996, Sky Classic; \$208,529, 2nd Bourbonette Breeders' Cup S). Love's Reason is the fifth foal and first stakes performer for her dam.

Mrs. J.W.Y. Martin Jr.'s Music Please won for the third time in three career starts while capturing the \$50,000 Squan Song Stakes on December 4 at Laurel Park.

Music Please was sent to post as the third choice in the field of six registered Maryland-bred fillies and mares, who were all in search of their first stakes victory. Under Eric Camacho, the homebred daughter of Bowman's Band rallied from last and was up in time to catch favorite Heaven's Voice just two jumps before the finish line. Heaven's Voice had put away My Misty's Echo in midstretch and appeared to be on her way to victory but could not hold off the winner, losing by three-quarters of a length. My Misty's Echo finished third.

Completing the field were Prom Time, Kincoralyn and Little Ice Patch.

Music Please stopped the timer in 1:25.97 for the seven furlongs. Each of her races has been at that distance over the Laurel surface.

"This filly has a lovely manner," said trainer Rodney Jenkins. "The first time I ran her seven furlongs because three-quarters was just too short. The second time I ran her seven furlongs because I had this race in mind. I want

to stretch her out but we'll stretch her out after this."

"Today she just sprinted right by them the last 60 yards," said Camacho. "We had a great pace going into it. I just got her to relax. I started to get after her around the turn. Her maturity has come a long way."

Music Please scored by a nose in her debut on October 20 and came back to win in allowance company on November 12. She has earned \$63,060.

The filly comes from a female family that traces back decades at Worthington Farms, the Glyndon, Md., establishment of Martin and her husband, who are best known by their nicknames, Glennie and Duck.

Music Please is the 10th foal and third stakes performer from her stakes-winning dam, Lady Beaumont, whose sire, Lord Gaylord, ranked among the nation's leading sires during his long stud career at Worthington Farms.

Lady Beaumont won the 1993 Maryland Million Lassie and placed in three other stakes, earning \$104,285. Her first foal, First Arrival (1996, g., Deputed Testamony), was a stakes winner of \$239,386. Lady Beaumont is also the dam of Beau's Trip (2002, f., Valley Crossing), who placed three times in the Maryland Million Ladies and earned \$171,520.

Music Please's second dam, Raja's Venus (Raja Baba—North of Venus, by Northern Dancer), is a full sister to Worthington Farm's longtime sire Northern Raja.
