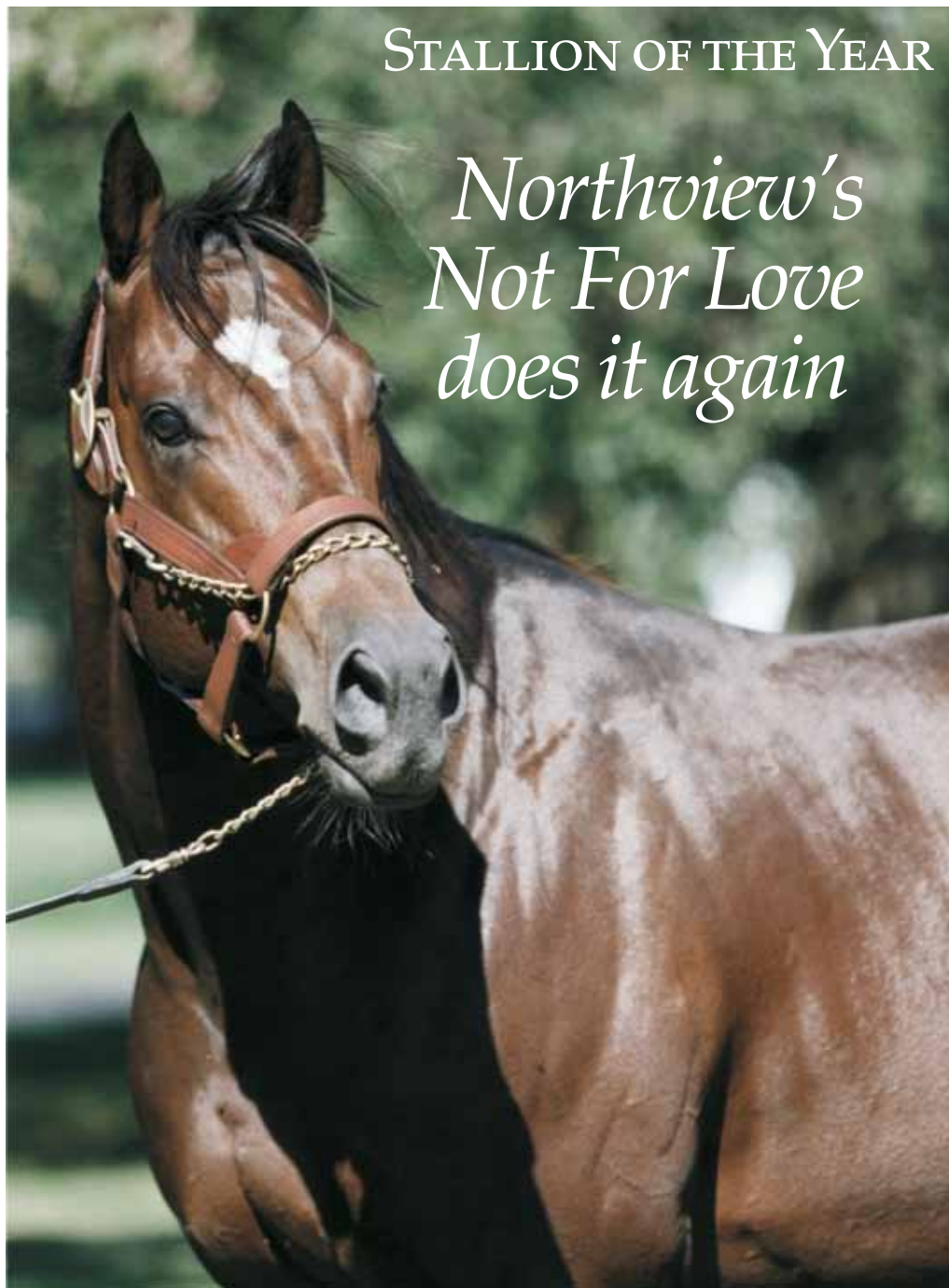

STALLION OF THE YEAR

*Northview's
Not For Love
does it again*

When it comes to numbers, statistics, data, achievements, you might know Not For Love.

Maryland's 2011 Stallion of the Year sired 96 winners to claim the award for the ninth time in the past 10

years. Those sons and daughters made 1,144 starts, won 171 races, earned \$4.1 million. Six of them—Brushed

by Love, Comet of Love, Eighttofastto catch, Love That Dance, Love's Blush, Not Aboard—won stakes.

But do you really know Not For Love?

He's 22. He's 16.1 hands. He commands a \$15,000 stud fee. He rules the historic stallion barn (once part of the legendary Windfields Farm) at Northview Stallion Station in Chesapeake City. He'll eat pretty much anything, but settles for a daily mash.

A day in his life starts with breakfast at 4 a.m., turnout at 6, a breeding session at 9, more turnout time, another breeding session at 2-ish, more turnout time, dinner at 4 p.m. and an evening of snoozing in his stall before it all starts again the next day. In a perfect world, Northview farm manager Louis Merryman would leave the son of Mr. Prospector outside all night, but that's not going to happen (insurance policies, weather, etc.).

"He's a very laid back old man, he's a sweetheart, about

the easiest stallion you'll ever want to be around," Merryman said of Not For Love. "But you don't want to get between him and his feed tub."

Not For Love can eat with the best of them, but might appreciate being outside even more than a feed tub full of grain, a sharp mint or a crisp apple.

"He loves going out in the morning, he's not bad about it, not nervous or high strung, but that's the one time he is on the muscle—on the way to his paddock in the morning," said Merryman. "You have to be on your game to get the shank off him because he'll flatten you. He 22s it from the gate to his dirt hole."

After flashing his quarter-mile speed, having a good roll, bellowing a few calls to the mares or his neighbors and gazing off in the horizon, the bay stallion goes back to being a horse—munching grass and keeping an eye on the farm's action.

"Of course, he walks in from the paddock like he's 22

years old again," said Merryman. "He's creaky, slow, takes his time. He's definitely a character."

Not For Love enjoyed a prolific 2011 thanks to a host of winners.

Maryland-bred hero Eighttofastto catch led the way with \$266,200 earned in 10 starts including five wins (all but one a stakes).

Maryland Million Day proved especially productive with a record-tying four wins (to give him 25 for his career). In the Classic, Eighttofastto catch powered a Not For Love trifecta over Cactus Charlie and Not Aboard.

A full-brother to champion Rhythm, Not For Love never won a stakes himself but has more than made up for the shortcoming via his progeny—gaining a reputation as an effective producer of runners, winners, success stories through 13 crops to race and counting.

Around the barn, he's the leader though the other horses might not notice.

"Some of the younger stallions don't listen to him, but he's setting the example, doing the right thing," said Merryman. "He can get a little grumpy when it's his time. You've got to respect that though."

He's entitled.

While at Kentucky's Ashford Stud, Merryman worked with top sire El Gran Senor, who lived to be 25.

They're only loosely related (via Buckpasser and Northern Dancer), but Not For Love makes the farm manager recall his former charge.

"Not For Love reminds me of a lot of those distinguished, older stallions," Merryman said. "He's got his stature in the barn. If you're good to him, he'll be good to you. At his age, he's doing really well. We do our best to help him and he wants to do what you want him to do."

And now you know.

Bowmans reclaim breeder award

After Robert Meyerhoff's back-to-back honors in 2009 and 2010, Dr. and Mrs. Tom Bowman earned their sixth Breeder of the Year award, knocking out more than \$2 million in earnings from 88 winners and five stakes winners. The Bowmans (and partners) bred such 2011 standouts as Jack's in the Deck, Concealed Identity, Bluegrass Atitude, Brushed by Love and Not Abroad.

Juvenile Jack's in the Deck led the way with \$205,260 in earnings, including the Grade 2 Futurity at Belmont Park for Skeedattle Associates and trainer Robin Graham.

The Bowmans led a contentious race at the top of the state's breeder standings. Mr. and Mrs. Charles McGinnes



and partners topped \$1.6 million in earnings led by dual Grade 1 winner Ask the Moon (co-bred by Country Life Farm). Stakes winners Bessie M and Glib also represented the breeders. Dark Hollow Farm and partners bred 38 winners of more than \$1.1 million including stakes winners Plum, Poseidon's Warrior and Eighttostocatch. 🍷

Baltimore pair lifts Gabby's Love

Broodmare of the Year Gabby's Love had a local flair in 2011 as the dam of stakes winners Baltimore Bob and Baltimore Belle. The duo combined to win six races and \$272,587 on the year—a fine legacy for Carol Kaye and Barbara Smith's mare.

Gabby's Love is also the granddam of 2011 stakes winner Action Andy (a winner of two stakes in his first two starts of 2012) and multiple winner Saintry Love.

"I wish I still had her," said Kaye, as the partners lost Gabby's Love from foaling complications in 2008. Fortunately for Kaye, who owns and operates Wellington Park farm in Woodbine, she still has a number of the matriarch's offspring.

Gabby's Love produced seven foals, her first in 1999—five were winners. In 2005, the same year her second foal, Gabianna, won Pimlico's The Very One Stakes, Gabby's Love dropped Baltimore Bob (by Malibu Moon).

The two-time stakes winner in 2010 returned last year to take the Grand Prairie Turf Challenge Stakes at Lone Star Park for owner Charles Fletcher and record two additional victories. Through March 4, Gabby's Love's only son had won 11 of 33 lifetime starts and \$377,217.

Baltimore Bob's half-sister, Baltimore Belle (2007, by Bowman's Band), collected the Lady Baltimore, Geisha and Dahlia Stakes in 2011 while racing for owner Larry Johnson and trainer Mike Trombeta.

Second in her first two starts of 2012—the Sleigh Ride and Maryland Racing Media Stakes—Baltimore Belle has won seven of 24 starts for earnings of \$344,064.

A foal of 1991, Gabby's Love made 42 lifetime starts

(all at Pimlico and Laurel) and won five times.

Third in the 1995 Maryland Million Ladies and Summertime Promise Stakes, the daughter of Perkin Warbeck was a full-sister to multiple stakes winner War Hostage (\$223,889, Humphrey S. Finney S, Spend a Buck S, etc.). Both were bred in Maryland by Schelford North Farm.

Kaye had kept an eye on Gabby's Love throughout the mare's racing career.

"I loved her pedigree, the *Vaguely Noble and Nijinsky II. . . and with her sire being named Perkin Warbeck [the stallion's namesake had laid claim to the English throne during the reign of King Henry VII in the late 1400s], she seemed to tie in with my English heritage."

Kaye bought Gabby's Love privately from John Polek as a broodmare prospect in 1997.

"Barbara came in a couple of years later, when Gabby's Love was in foal to Malibu Moon," said Kaye of her longtime friend. "Barbara was looking to get into the business, and I am so thankful to her for having faith in me and making a substantial investment into Gabby's Love. The first foal we bred was Baltimore Bob."

With Gabby's Love's growing reputation as a dam of stakes producers, Kaye remains grateful to have her daughters Love Me Twice, the dam of Action Andy, and Saint Dinorah, Gabby's Love's final foal.

Love Me Twice has a yearling colt by Great Notion and is due to foal this April to Temple City (who is from the same family as Malibu Moon). The unraced Saint Dinorah (by St Averil), will be bred for the first time this spring, and has a date with Successful Appeal. 🍷

MARYLAND-BRED STAKES WINNERS

Action Andy remains perfect at Tampa Bay in 2012

Robert Gerczak's Action Andy, the 9-10 favorite, pulled away in the stretch to take the \$50,000 Super Stakes at Tampa Bay Downs on Feb. 11 over Watch Me Go, winner of last year's Tampa Bay Derby-G2. Action Andy completed 7 furlongs on the main track in 1:23.22.

It was Action Andy's fourth win in six starts at Tampa Bay—he also has two seconds—over the past two seasons. The Carlos Garcia-trained runner, winner of

Tampa Bay's Pelican Stakes on Jan. 7, increased his lifetime earnings to \$187,670. From 21 starts, he has six wins, seven seconds and three thirds.

Gerczak and Garcia planned to savor the victory before deciding what's next for Action Andy.

"We don't have any other plans right now, but I'd like to keep him here because the people have been nice to us," Garcia said. "And he loves this track, loves the surface."

"He has everything going for him right now," Gerczak said. "Six furlongs, 7 furlongs, turf, mud—he is a very versatile horse."



Bred in Maryland by Garcia's former wife, Carol Kaye, Action Andy is the first foal out of Love Me Twice (by Not For Love), a half-sister to stakes winners Baltimore Bob (\$377,217, Da Hoss S, etc.), Baltimore Belle (\$344,064, Maryland Million Oaks, etc.) and Gabianna (\$136,610, The Very One S).

Baltimore Bob and Baltimore Belle are still in training. The latter, a three-time stakes

winner in 2011, finished second in the Maryland Racing Media Stakes at Laurel Park a little over an hour before the Super Stakes.

Gerczak, who owns an insurance agency in White Stone, Va., purchased Action Andy for \$15,000 at the 2010 Fasig-Tipton Midlantic December Mixed sale when the gelding was sold to dissolve the Kaygar/Gerczak Stable partnership.
