Though these events will be held without spectators, they will all be available via livestream on the revamped marylandhorse.com.

2 Selflessly storms home in Saratoga's Grade 3 Lake George

Klaravich Stables' Selflessly made every moment count in the Grade 3 Lake George as she sped down the stretch to hit the wire a nose ahead of 3-5 favorite Sweet Melania at Saratoga Aug. 28.

Making her third consecutive start against Sweet Melania, Selflessly settled mid-pack and made her charge around the final turn, going after Sweet Melania, who found her opening on the inside. Nearing the wire, Selflessly just got up, getting the mile on good turf in 1:36.06 while defeating nine other 3-year-old fillies for jockey David Cohen.

"My team at Belmont has had this horse all meet getting her ready and they really did a great job," said trainer Chad Brown. "David stepped in today when Irad [Ortiz Jr.] couldn't ride and I'm really proud of him. He rode a great race and we were happy to put him on the horse."

Finishing second in her debut at Saratoga last August, Selflessly followed up with a win in the Miss Grillo Stakes-G2 at Belmont Park, breaking her maiden and securing her first graded victory all in one step. In November, the daughter of More Than Ready finished fifth in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies Turf-G1, as fellow Maryland-bred Sharing won and Sweet Melania finished third.

Selflessly made her sophomore debut in the Wonder Again Stakes-G3 at Belmont in June. Stumbling at the start, she finished last in the field of five behind Sweet Melania.

"The first race of the year I was a little disappointed watching the race unfold and when we got her back to the barn, she had some cuts on the backs of her legs," said Brown. "She missed some training after that race to heal up, so she probably had an excuse."

Selflessly improved to 2-1-0 from five starts for earnings of \$219,000. She was purchased as a weanling for \$190,000 by De Meric Stables, out of the 2017 Keeneland November breeding stock sale.

Selflessly is the second foal out of George Louis Doetsch Jr.'s Grand Slam mare Uniformly Yours. The first is multiple stakes winner Enchanted Ghost (by Ghostzapper), sold by Doetsch as a yearling for

\$75,000. She brought \$335,000 at Fasig-Tipton Kentucky's fall mixed sale last year.

Also out of Uniformly Yours is the filly Honor Yours (Honor Code), sold for \$100,000 at the 2019 Keeneland September sale; a yearling colt by Kitten's Joy, who brought \$500,000 as a weanling at last year's Keeneland November sale; and a weanling colt by Kitten's Joy. She was bred to More Than Ready for 2021. 🐾

Introduced relishes Saratoga mud in Smart N Fancy Stakes

Unfazed by the switch from turf to dirt, Introduced eased through the rain and the mud to take the Smart N Fancy Stakes by 3¼ lengths at Saratoga Aug. 27.

The field of five quickly gave way to a two-horse race between Peaceful and Introduced, who broke to the front and dueled to the final turn through fractions of :22.41 and :44.84. As they turned for home, Introduced burst ahead to increase her lead and secure her second stakes victory. Final time for 5½ furlongs was 1:03.06.

The 4-year-old daughter of El Padrino won for the third time in as many starts on dirt as she boosted her overall record to 6-3-1 from 13 starts, with \$271,551 earned.

She finished second in her career debut at Saratoga be-

fore breaking her maiden by 3 lengths in Laurel last September. She ended the season with a second in her stakes debut, the Stewart Manor at Aqueduct, in November. At 3, she captured an allowance before finishing third in the Stormy Blues Stakes, then scored her first stakes victory in the Miss Disco, all at Laurel.

This year, the Jorge Duarte Jr. trainee has three wins from four starts, including back-to-back allowance wins at Laurel and Delaware. She was fourth in Saratoga's Caress Stakes on Aug. 1.

Bred by Sycamore Hall Thoroughbreds, the chestnut filly sold for \$30,000 at the Fasig-Tipton Midlantic fall sale as a yearling before selling for \$310,000 as a 2-year-old to Charlie Boden, agent. Introduced is one of eight foals the

Cherokee Run mare Stuttgart has produced. All six of the mare's foals of racing age have started; four are winners.

A half-sister to Maryland-bred champion Giant Run, stakes winner and stakes producer American Victory, and

graded stakes-placed stakes producer Who's Cozy, Stuttgart has a yearling colt by Golden Lad, an April filly this

year by Madefromlucky and was bred back to Madefromlucky.
