It bears repeating: Bowmans are state's top breeder again

The accolades continue to flow for Dr. and Mrs. R. Thomas Bowman, as the couple has been named Maryland's Breeder of the Year for the fourth consecutive year and fifth time overall. The Bowmans also won in 1998.

Solely or in partnership, the Bowmans bred four stakes winners in 2008, each a Maryland-bred champion. For the second year in a row, the top runner to represent them was Good Night Shirt, the son of Concern and Hot Story (by Two Punch) who was awarded his second Eclipse Award in 2008 as the nation's top steeplechaser. Also named 2008 Maryland-bred Horse of the Year, Good Night Shirt led state-breds with earnings of \$485,520 last year and was undefeated in five starts, all National Steeplechase Association Grade 1 races.

The other champions were older mare Smart and Fancy (2003, Not For Love—Substitute Teacher, by Shelter Half); 2-year-old colt Peace Town (Peace Rules—Darnestown, by Williamstown), bred in partnership with Milton Higgins; and 3-year-old male Willsboro Point (Point Given—Petrouchka, by Red Ransom), co-bred with Dr. Jason Layfield and The Thoroughbred Corp.



Bowman-bred runners have put up consistent numbers, amassing \$2.6 million each of the past three seasons.

The Bowmans, who have bred and raced horses in Maryland for more than 30 years, maintain two Maryland farms—Dance Forth Farm in

Chestertown and Roland Farm in Chesapeake City (the latter co-owned by Dr. and Mrs. Bijoy Ghosh). Thomas Bowman is a veterinarian specializing in equine reproduction as well as a co-founding owner and general manager of Northview Stallion Station in Ches-

peake City and Northview PA, in Peach Bottom, Pa.

The Bowmans also own 2008 Maryland Broodmare of the Year, Hot Story.

Bred by famed singer/songwriter/composer Burt Bacharach's Blue Seas Music Inc., Hot Story, a daughter of Two Punch, was foaled in West Virginia at Country

Roads Farm, operated by the late Vinnie Moscarelli and his wife, Suzanne.

After competing for four seasons, earning \$68,039 and hitting the board in 12 of 16 starts, including a second-place finish in the West Virginia Lottery Stakes as a 5-year-old in 1994, Hot Story was retired to Country Roads, joining her dam, stakes win-

ner Media Girl (by T. V. Commercial).

The Country Roads operation moved to Maryland's Eastern Shore in Warwick in 1996, and Bowman bought Hot Story privately about four years later from Suzanne Moscarelli in a package with two other mares. One of them – Substitute Teacher, by Shelter Half – is the dam of 2008 Maryland-bred champion Smart and Fancy.

The first foal Hot Story produced for the Bowmans was Good Night Shirt, in 2001. With 13 wins from 31 starts, Good Night Shirt is \$30,917 shy of the \$1 million mark in career earnings.

Hot Story since has produced four foals, three named, including 2008 multiple stakes-placed Story of a Lion, a daughter of Lion Hearted with five wins and earnings of nearly \$160,000.

Because none of her foals "fit the bill as race horses" at the time, Bowman had given away Hot Story in 2006 to "a lady who breeds Warmbloods." But the Bowmans since have gotten her back.

Hot Story, now 20, was one of the final mares that longtime Northview Stallion Station sire Waquoit covered in 2007 before his death. Unfortunately, the resulting foal also died. "The foal was huge, and we just couldn't get him out in time," noted Bowman.

Not bred for 2009, Hot Story is considered retired. But Bowman doesn't rule out the possibility of breeding her in the future. "It would be more based on sentiment if we were to breed her again," the veterinarian noted.

One who shows no signs of slowing is 2008 Stallion of the Year Not For Love. Just when it was thought he couldn't have a better year, he knocked it out of the park in 2008.

To earn his sixth Stallion of the Year title, Not For Love did something no other Maryland sire had ever done—he had progeny earnings of over \$6 million for the year. Not only was it a new mark for his home state, but it established a record for any stallion standing outside of Kentucky, bettering the \$6.2 million set by Florida stallion Silver Buck in 1998. Not For Love has ranked as the nation's leading sire standing outside of Kentucky (by North American earnings) for six consecutive years.

Not For Love (previously Maryland's Stallion of the Year in 2002, '03, '04, '06 and '07) had 201 starters earn \$6,424,787. His leading earner was Maryland Million Classic winner Cuba (\$393,180), named New Jersey-bred champion older horse of 2008.

Not For Love was represented by 13 other stakes winners last year, including Maryland-bred champion Smart and Fancy and New Jersey-bred champion 2-year-old filly Love That Dance, as well as multiple graded stakes winner Akronism. He was also the sire of 17 stakes-placed runners in 2008.

The 19-year-old son of Mr. Prospector—Dance Number, by Northern Dancer, has made his career at Richard Golden and Thomas Bowman's Northview Stallion Station. 🐾

Yearling Show participants split \$40,000 in purse premiums

The MHBA Yearling Show purse premiums, worth \$40,000 to exhibitors of the top four 2008 money-winning Maryland-breds shown the previous two years, have been determined. The top awards of \$13,000 will go to the exhibitors of Avonian, shown in 2006, and Onearestbandit, participant of the 2007 show, with checks to be presented at the MHBA's annual awards dinner on Friday, April 17, at the Hilton Garden Inn in White Marsh, Md.

Avonian, a son of Not for Love out of Mine Inning, whom Preakness-winning trainer Tim Ritchey awarded a third-place ribbon in Class

I, was exhibited by his breeder, William Beatson Jr. Last year, Avonian earned \$74,800 and finished second in the Maryland Million Sprint Starter Handicap.

The top three money-winning 3-year-olds were separated by less than \$2,500. Safe Journey, shown by Dark Hollow Farm, earns a purse premium of \$4,000, having amassed \$72,895. It's Not for Love (shown by Roland Farm) finished third with \$72,634, for a \$2,000 award. Stakes-placed Outside Lane earned \$67,020, with exhibitor John Foster the recipient of \$1,000.

Onearestbandit, a stakes-winning daughter of No Ar-

mistice, easily took title as the top-earning 2-year-old of the 2007 show, having amassed \$138,960. Her breeder, David Daniel, is the award recipient.

Stakes-placed Fools in Love bankrolled \$84,266 for the runner-up award of \$4,000, to be presented to Bob Manfuso and Katy Voss. Dark Hollow Farm and William Beatson will take home \$2,000 for Matrimony, an earner of \$32,000. And \$1,000 for fourth goes to Brice Ridgely for Blueberry's Start (\$30,120). Preakness winning trainer Tom Albertrani was judge for the 2007 Yearling Show. 🐾
