BRUSHED BY LOVE stalked the early pace, alertly was sent up along the rail to engage LOVE'S REASON entering the turn, dueled to inside the eighth pole then drew off under brisk urging. BLUSHING B. J. circled the turn three wide, chased the pace and gained the place in deep stretch. LOVE'S REASON, quickly clear, set the pace in the two path, was challenged leaving the backstretch, dueled with the winner to inside the eighth pole, weakened and drifted out near the sixteenth pole. ART OF THE HUNT chased the pace four wide, floated very wide near the quarter pole, remained on her left lead and flattened out. PAGAN PRIESTESS steadily dropped back.

BEN'S CAT , patiently rated four to five wide while well within striking distance, responded to solid hand pressure leaving the quarter pole, forged ahead of STEADY WARRIOR leaving the eighth pole, was given a few taps right handed to stay focused then edged clear at the wire. STEADY WARRIOR prompted the pace four wide, kicked clear leaving the three sixteenths marker, lugged in under left handed pressure, was overtaken inside the furlong pole, dueled briefly then gave way grudgingly while well clear of the rest. HEAVEN'S VOICE , taken to rate inside, moved to engage DISCO DANDY entering the lane, briefly went clear inside the quarter pole then proved no match through the final furlong. COLONY CLUB settled back while saving ground, edged a bit closer entering the lane, steadied when put in close near the three sixteenths pole, shifted out, finished with interest but failed to threaten. FRISKIE J rated forwardly three wide between rivals nearing the turn, was asked around the turn, shifted out some near mid stretch but failed to respond. NATURAL SEVEN stalked the pace between rivals, shifted in past the three sixteenths pole and gave way. DISCO DANDY cleared early and set the pace three wide, was collared approaching the stretch, gave little resistance and faltered inside the quarter pole.

BLUEGRASS ATATUDE bore out sharply leaving the starting gate, advanced outside horses on the turn, swung very wide entering the stretch, swept to command in upper stretch then drew out under vigorous rousing. TAXI DANCER worked between horses on the turn, entered the stretch in the four path and closed late. NASTAR MEDALLIST , steadied behind the winner soon after the break, angled to the inner rail entering the stretch, advanced to midstretch then failed to sustain her bid. JAZZY IDEA chased the pace outside GOOD LOOKING GIRL, was fanned wide by that one entering the stretch, remained prominent to deep stretch and weakened. MONSTER SLEEPING , very wide on the turn, rallied mildly. GOOD LOOKING GIRL sped to the front, drifted out leaving the turn then gave way in upper stretch. VICTORIA'S COMET lacked speed, raced inside horses on the turn and failed to be a factor. RAVENESQUE saved ground on the turn and was outrun. LA REINE'S WAGER , between horses on the turn, angled to the rail in midstretch and was outrun. ROCK N MARY raced slightly off the rail on the turn, chased the pace and gave way entering the stretch. RILEY'S RAMPAGE hugged the rail on the turn and gave way entering the stretch. ROMANCE PROJECT , wide entering the stretch, was outrun. MISSY KIM was outrun.

LOVE THAT DANCE moved clear along the rail nearing the five eighths pole, set a moderate pace under rating, turned back a challenge from LISTENTOTHEWINDBLO after a half mile, kicked back clear leaving the five sixteenths marker, responded to steady right handed pressure inside the eighth pole, dug in when collared sixty yards out and prevailed. SILVER HEART vied outside the winner leaving the chute, stalked that one past the five eighths pole, eased back between rivals around the far turn, came under urging mid turn, closed well through the final sixteenth and just missed. FOOLS IN LOVE , taken to rate inside early, angled out mid turn, moved up five wide between rivals into the stretch, straightened away for the drive and closed steadily. LILY QUATORZE , brushed at the break, recovered and was taken in hand, moved up four wide past the three eighths pole to reach a striking position, sustained her run past the eighth pole then flattened out late. SHORDAWATYADRINK lacked speed, swung to the five path entering the stretch, closed strongly, was brushed by SWALLOW THE FIELD inside the sixteenth pole and drove clear late. SWALLOW THE FIELD prompted the pace outside PLEASE SIR, sprinted clear entering the stretch, drifted out inside the sixteenth pole and gave way grudgingly. MONEY FOR LOVE lacked speed, angled to the five path in upper stretch, rallied and came inside the top pair inside the eighth pole. SAINTLY LOVE , along the rail entering the turn, swung to the four path near the quarter pole and was not a factor. QUARTERS stalked the pace, raced in the three path on the turn and gave way in the drive. KNOCKED OUT , along the rail turning for home, was not a factor. NIGHT Q , in the three path on the turn, gave way in entering the stretch. PLEASE SIR showed speed along the rail and faltered in upper stretch.
